# Who are the Saudi Hijazis?

The Saudi Hijazis are the majority peoples in the Western Province of Saudi Arabia. They were previously under Hashemite rule until they lost their ruling power to the Al Saud Family (from the Najd tribe) who joined with the strict Wahabi sect to form the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in 1932. Their culture, though often diminished by the Najdis, remains unique. They simultaneously view themselves as traditional and cosmopolitan; as forward-thinking as well as deeply religiously conservative.

Hijazis are among the descendants of Mohammad and are specially entrusted as the keepers of Islam's Holy cities of Medina and Mecca. They view themselves as Islam's Chosen People. As keepers of the Holy Cities, the Hajj is a very critical component of who they are. Unlike many Muslims for which the Hajj is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity, the Hijazis do so with regularity. One-third of the 2.3 million Hajj pilgrims at any given time are Saudi and mostly Hijazi. It is a deep part of their religious identity and responsibility.



They are a people that cherish the past and also innovate towards the future. They are home to KAUST, one of the world's leading science and technology Universities, and are in the process of building NEOM, promising to become one of the most advanced smart cities. They want to be a beacon of light reckoning back to the Islamic Golden Age.
